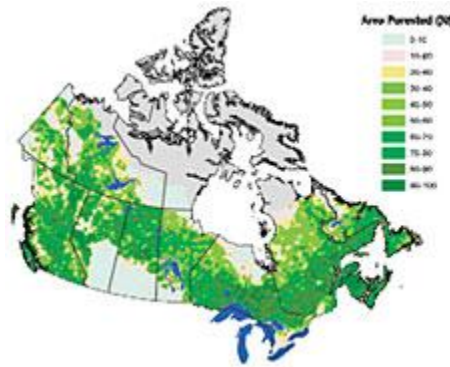


There is Not Enough Wood?

Figure 4.3 — Commercial/institutional energy use by end-use, 2008 (percent)

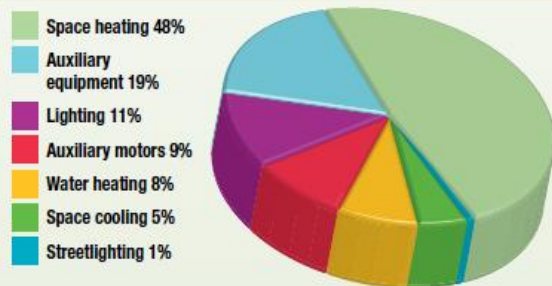


Figure 3.3 — Distribution of residential energy use by end-use, 2008 (percent)
